Events, Travel & Communication

TODOS organised a number of academic and social events in the autumn of 2022, here ordered chronologically.

BBQ

We organised a BBQ in Tromsø at the start of the semester, using the outdoor grills to the north of the BFE building. There was a good attendance and many mouths to fill, and Larry (Chair of Social Events) held a team quiz.

Writing retreat to Malangen

Keeping up the tradition from last semester, we again organised a weekend writing retreat to Malangen resort in November. These retreats provide a great opportunity to get writing and other work done in a calm and focussed environment. At the same time, it's a unique opportunity to get to know fellow PhD candidates and postdocs from all disciplines. This time we had 22 participants.



SiN Annual General Meeting

Two TODOS board members travelled to the annual general meeting of SiN (Stipendiat i Norge, our umbrella organisation) on 26 November in Kristiansand. The most important business was agreeing on a budget and electing an entirely new board for 2023. SiN represents more than 90% of PhD candidates in Norway through the local member organisations and does advocacy work representing our interests in various arenas. They reply to formal calls for feedback from the government and write position statements on topics such as internationalisation and quality in PhD education. During the trip to Kristiansand we also met and got to exchange views and experiences with PhD candidates from most other universities in Norway.

Academic Newsletter

We have begun working on developing two newsletters. The first is a regular TODOS newsletter containing information about TODOS events and happenings in addition to invitations to events relevant to PhDs and postdocs. The second is a bi-annual academic newsletter for PhD candidates and postdocs at UiT, which contains information about important deadlines as well as academic offers for the new semester. These are mainly located at UiT, but relevant offers from other institutions or organisations may be included.

Christmas Gala

For the first time since the pandemic, we finally have the possibility to throw a proper Christmas party! The food is free at this dinner event right after our general assembly, and we will even have live musical entertainment. The event is filling up to the maximum capacity of 70 participants. Parallel events are being funded and organised in Alta, Harstad & Narvik.



Advocacy and outreach

As always, apart from organising events we also keep busy with more "invisible" work. What follows is a summary of our advocacy and outreach work over the past semester:

- We have actively represented the interest of our member base in the university committee on research strategy (forskningsstrategisk utvalg).
- We have given a lecture on PhD supervision in Results supervision course.
- We have presented TODOS at the bi-annual welcoming meeting for newly employed foreigners.
- We are representing PhD candidates on the newly created steering board for the High North Academy.
- We have responded to a request for feedback on proposed changes to the organisation of Results course on pedagogics for PhD candidates, recommending that the course should give ECTS but also have the option to count towards duty work.
- We are sending a representative to the kick-off meeting of EUGLOH 2.0 (European university collaboration that now includes UiT) in January in München.



Spending autumn 2022

Our spending for the autumn of 2022 has been on track, with most of the spending concentrated around two main events: the writing retreat and the Christmas gala. The following gives an overview:

Provisional budget 2023

TODOS receives kr 450 000 per year from UiT, with about half going to board member compensation. Currently we also have assets from previous years of around kr 266 000 (a significant reason being reduced expenses during the pandemic), giving us a healthy margin for unexpected expenses. However, we intend to keep spending around kr 450 000 and not use up our reserves without good reason. The following is an outline of our provisional budget for 2023, by main expense categories. For more details, see the separate budget attached to the AGM invitation.
