Activities

Due to the pandemic, we were still rather limited in our possibilities for creating new events.

We were able to provide a few online events which will be presented here.

We decided to focus this time more on internal work and establishing a deeper cooperation with certain members of UiT.

Shut up and work!

This semester, we were able to continue our digital sessions of "Shut up and Work!". These sessions provide a platform for the participants to focus on their work and stay motivated.

In total, we were able to hold 20 sessions of Shut up and work! so far in 2021.

We are meeting on Mondays at Zoom from 8:45 to 12:00.

This semester we were able to add short sessions about "writing advices" in the beginning of each session.

TODOS changed the name from "Shut up and write!" to "Shut up and work!" to be more inclusive for our members who are currently not writing but working on other parts of their projects. In the beginning of each session, we start with setting our goals for this day and continue with three working period of 50 minutes each, followed by a 10 minutes break.



CV Workshop



On the 21.01.2021, TODOS organized a CV workshop in collaboration with the High North Academy. Around 15 of our members attended. It included a three hour online workshop programme, including presentations and a review of the CV.

ISK seminar on impact of Covid-19

The department of language and culture (ISK) invited TODOS to hold a workshop about the impact of Covid-19 on the 29.04.2021.

12 PhD candidates and 1 postdoc attended the seminar.

The most important lesson learned here is the need of a platform for PhD candidates and postdocs to meet and getting the opportunity to discuss the issues which are making our lives harder in the current situation.

Internal work

Board meetings

Our TODOS board meets regularly to discuss current issues, plan events and explore what else we could do to make your PhD and postdoc lives better! This semester we were meeting digitally for in total 7 board meetings. One important topic this semester was the inclusion of the other campuses of UiT, especially Harstad, Alta and Narvik.

Committees/Workgroups

TODOS is currenly represented in several committees:

- Forskningsstrategisk utvalg (Research strategic council): It is a committee with representatives from each faculty, discussing research strategy, meaning the most important questions are about funding and priorities.
- ARA workgroup (Arctic Resilience Accelerator): A workgroup that is developing a research school for research in the Arctic
- UiT's Prize Committee

Meetings with UiT

We continued the regularly meetings with the staff representative for the temporarily staff at the university board and the administration section for research and education quality. This semester, these meetings were focusing mainly on the Covid-19 pandemic and its impact on us and our members. A second pillar has been to collaborate on a annual PhD survey at UiT and negotiate the budget.

Quarterly meetings with SiN

TODOS is a member of SiN (Stipendiatorganisasjonene i Norge), the national organization for PhD candidates, postdocs and early career researchers.

Meeting for new internationals employees

We were finally able to continue the collaboration with with International Cooperation Office and presented TODOS at their two introductory meetings in January and April.

Budget

TODOS receives a set amount of 250,000 NOK to host activities for PhDs and Postdocs and cover the operational costs. This money is used for the board member compensation, for different activities and events and to cover the fixed bills.

- Our membership in SiN (Stipendiatorganisasjonene i Norge) requires a fixed membership fee of 2,000 NOK every year.
- 150,000 NOK per year are allocated for the compensation of board members. This is equal to a value of 25,000 NOK per year and board member, and the compensation goes either to a contract extension of two weeks, 100 hours of teaching duties or to the annum (project money).

Available budget 2021

For 2021, TODOS received the 250,000 NOK plus an extra of 134,244 NOK from the budget of 2020. This semester TODOS did not have any costs for events as they were all fully digital and cabin trips/writing retreats not possible.

Taking out the board member compensations and the fixed bill for SiN, we have left 232,244 NOK for activities throughout 2021.
