# 4. Organized events and activities for PhD candidates and postdocs

### 4.1 Shut up and work! sessions

This semester, we were able to continue our digital "Shut up and Work!"-sessions. These sessions provide a platform for the participants to focus on their work and stay motivated. In total, we were able to hold 32 Shut up and work!-sessions in 2021 in Tromsø, and we also established weekly sessions at our campus in Harstad.



We are meeting on Mondays on Zoom from 8:45 to 12:00. This semester we were able to add short sessions about "writing

advice" in the beginning of each session. TODOS changed the name from "Shut up and write!" to "Shut up and work!" to be more inclusive of our members who are currently not writing but working on other parts of their projects. In the beginning of each session, we start with setting our goals for this day and continue with three working periods of 50 minutes each, followed by a 10-minute break.

### 4.2 CV Workshop

On the 21.01.2021, TODOS organized a CV workshop in collaboration with the High North Academy. Around 15 of our members attended. This included a three-hour online workshop program, including presentations and a review of the CV.

### 4.3 ISK seminar on impact of Covid-19

The department of language and culture (ISK) invited TODOS to hold a workshop about the impact of Covid-19 on the 29.04.2021. 12 PhD candidates and 1 postdoc attended the seminar. The most important lesson learned here was in regard to the need for a platform for PhD candidates and postdocs to meet and have the opportunity to discuss the issues which are making our lives harder in the current situation.

# 4.4 Writing retreat

TODOS organized a writing retreat to Malangen Resort for 24 participants. We spent two nights in the resort, from the 5<sup>th</sup> to the 7<sup>th</sup> of November. During this retreat, we also held a mini-workshop with peer feedback on each other's work.







# 4.5 Workshop in supervision course

TODOS was invited in October to the PhD supervision course for supervisors at UiT. Here, we first conducted a short survey on how PhD candidates at UiT perceive their supervision. Based on the answers, we organized a course session. We also took part inan interview for a short film introducing the supervision course.

September: TODOS BBQ at Bak Olsen on the 9th of September with 15 participants






**October**: TODOS Movie Night on campus at UiT with 12 participants, watching 'Hunt for the Wilderpeople' as selected in our online Facebook poll.




# 4.8 Survey for the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic




# Missed activities What activities did you miss most? Workshops PhD Courses Networking events Conferences Should UiT organize more of such events after the pandemic?

### 5. Internal work

### 5.1 Board meetings

Our TODOS board meets regularly to discuss current issues, plan events and explore what else we could do to make your PhD and postdoc lives better! This semester we met mostly digitally for our board meetings 7 times in total. A lot of discussion was had in these meetings regarding how we can improve the inclusion of the other campuses of UiT, in particular Harstad, Alta and Narvik.

### **5.2 Committees/Workgroups**

TODOS is currently represented in several committees:

Forskningsstrategisk utvalg (Research strategic council): A committee with representatives from each faculty, discussing research strategy, meaning the most important questions are about funding and priorities. Acts as an advisory council to the University Board.

ARA workgroup (Arctic Resilience Accelerator): A group that is developing a school for research in the Arctic

UiT's Prize Committee

Forskningsetisk utvalg (Research ethics council)

### 5.3 Meetings with UiT

We continued the regular meetings with the representative for temporary staff at the university board and the administration section for research and education quality. This year, these meetings were focused mainly on the Covid-19 pandemic and its impact on us and our members. A second pillar has been to collaborate on an annual PhD survey at UiT and negotiate the budget.

### 5.4 Quarterly meetings and general assembly with SiN

TODOS is a member of SiN (Stipendiatorganisasjonene i Norge), the national organization for PhD candidates, postdocs and early career researchers. We joined their three digital quarterly meetings and sent two delegates to the SiN Annual General Assembly in Bergen on the 27.11.2021.

### 5.5 Meeting for new internationals employees

We were finally able to continue the collaboration with the International Cooperation Office and presented TODOS at their two introductory meetings in January, April and September.

#### 5.6 PhD conference in Narvik

Same to last year, TODOS again was invited to the PhD conference in Narvik in December 2021 to present our work and keep up the communication with PhD candidates and postdocs in Narvik.

#### 5.7 Statutes

In preparation of the upcoming general assembly, we have drafted an updated version of the TODOS statutes. The biggest changes relate to including representatives from our various campuses other than Tromsø, in addition to a few smaller improvements.

# 6. Budget

In 2021, TODOS received a set amount of 250,000 NOK to host activities for PhDs and Postdocs and cover the operational costs. In addition, TODOS received 134,244 NOK from the budget of 2020. This money is used for the board member compensation, for activities and events and to cover the fixed bills.

- Our membership in SiN (Stipendiatorganisasjonene i Norge) requires a fixed membership fee of 2,000 NOK every year.
- 150,000 NOK per year are allocated for the compensation of board members. This is equal to
  a value of 25,000 NOK per year and board member, and the compensation goes either to a
  contract extension of two weeks, 100 hours of teaching duties or to the annum (project
  money).

In 2021, the board members' compensation was allocated as follows: 75,000 NOK for 2021 and 10,000 NOK for 2020. 25,000 NOK extra were spent due to the missing payment for the Chair of Communications in 2020.

During spring 2021, TODOS did not have any costs for events as they were all fully digital, and cabin trips/writing retreats were not possible.

The 2021 autumn activities cost as follow: 571 NOK for TODOS BBQ at Bak Olsen, 18,514 NOK for summer gathering with pizza and election, 3,000 NOK for printing the PhD booklet, and 982 NOK for business travel. Lastly, TODOS partially paid the writing retreat with 52,120 NOK, and the participants covered the remaining cost with 52,800 NOK.

By the end of 2021, TODOS has left 132,057 NOK for the new year.

From 2022, TODOS's budget increased to a yearly amount of 450,000 NOK.

# 7. Way forward

We are looking forward to a new year with great events and activities. The increased budget will allow us to organize more events such as writing retreats, cabin trips and regularly meetings.

One of our ambitions is to promote TODOS more among our campuses outside of Tromsø, especially in Harstad, Narvik and Alta, and to reach out more to our Norwegian members.

We will also continue the internal work, discussions and negotiations we started this semester with our partners at UiT, SiN and inside the committees.
